

Five Quick Ways to Redesign your Cafeteria for Less Than \$10

- 1. Put fruits in bright plastic bowls. Plastic bowls make cleaning easy and the bright colors make fruits stand out more.
- 2. Use white erase board to advertise your menu. It's a perfect alternative for window service. It will brighten up windows and allow students to learn about their menu options. Make sure to use creative names to describe what's for lunch.



- 3. Use vinyl tablecloths. You can dress up a serving cart for fruits, utensils or condiments by using bright and fun tablecloths. Vinyl tablecloths are durable and easy to clean.
- 4. Put up bright, colorful posters. Maximize your wall space by putting up posters of MyPlate or of fruits and vegetables.
