## SAFE DRINKING WATER SNAPSHOT

More than one million Californians lack access to safe drinking water. The lack of safe drinking water is a threat to food security. The CalFresh Safe Drinking Water Pilot gives \$50/month in benefits to more than 4,800 people in select zip codes that lack access to safe drinking water.

## A MAJORITY OF CALIFORNIANS DO NOT TRUST THE SAFETY OF THEIR TAP WATER\*

This distrust is highest in the counties surrounding Los Angeles (60%) and the Central Valley/Central Coast (64%)

## As a result: 72% of respondents buy bottled water as an alternative

Half of CalFresh recipients use their benefits to buy bottled water

Survey respondents spent \$80 or less on bottled water per month (1)

(1) The original survey question asked respondents how much was spent on bottled water each week. This value was re-calculated to estimate a monthly expense. "I have a water jug here that I fill up. I got three of them and it costs me \$2.50 to fill a 5-gallon up.

And with a family of six we go through three 5-gallon jugs a week.

It will go quick because of the weather lately, because of the heat. You know, you got to have it to stay hydrated."
